Examples of approved items

The grant must be used to purchase safety equipment that PREVENTS accidents. This includes, but is not limited to, items below.

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Falls
 - o Lanyards, lifelines, harnesses, connectors, D-rings, snaphooks, anchorages
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Clothing/Shoes/Hats
 - Reflective vests or shirts
 - Fire resistant suits, coveralls, pants or shirts
 - Disposable clothing or coveralls
 - Aprons
 - Steel-toed boots/shoes, non-slip shoes, metatarsal guards
 - Hard hats
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Hands/Ear/Eye
 - o Rubber, leather, metal mesh, fabric and cut/chemical-resistant gloves
 - Earplugs, earmuffs
 - Safety glasses, face shields, welding hoods/goggles
 - Welding curtains
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Respiratory
 - Particulate respirators, air-purifying respirators, powered air-purifying respirators (PAPR), supplied-air respirators (SAR), self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)
- Ergonomic Equipment
 - Ergonomic tools, ergonomic chairs, ergonomic keyboard trays, lifts (table lifts, air/roller tables, counterbalanced hoists, platform lifts – for lifting equipment, NOT aerial/fork lifts)
- Industrial Hygiene Equipment
 - Gas meters
 - Sound level meters/dosimeters
- Machine Guarding
 - o Interlocks
 - Light curtains
 - o Shields
