

Examples of approved items

The grant must be used to purchase safety equipment that PREVENTS accidents. This includes, but is not limited to, items below.

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Falls
 - o Lanyards, lifelines, harnesses, connectors, D-rings, snaphooks, anchorages
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Clothing/Shoes/Hats
 - o Reflective vests or shirts
 - o Fire resistant suits, coveralls, pants or shirts
 - o Disposable clothing or coveralls
 - o Aprons
 - o Steel-toed boots/shoes, non-slip shoes, metatarsal guards
 - o Hard hats
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Hands/Ear/Eye
 - o Rubber, leather, metal mesh, fabric and cut/chemical-resistant gloves
 - o Earplugs, earmuffs
 - o Safety glasses, face shields, welding hoods/goggles
 - o Welding curtains
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Respiratory
 - o Particulate respirators, air-purifying respirators, powered air-purifying respirators (PAPR), supplied-air respirators (SAR), self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)
- Ergonomic Equipment
 - o Ergonomic tools, ergonomic chairs, ergonomic keyboard trays, lifts (table lifts, air/roller tables, counterbalanced hoists, platform lifts – for lifting equipment, NOT aerial/fork lifts)
- Industrial Hygiene Equipment
 - o Gas meters
 - o Sound level meters/dosimeters
- Machine Guarding
 - o Interlocks
 - o Light curtains
 - o Shields
